



## Arriving by Bus

The northbound Greyhound Lines bus arrives in Brattleboro at 11:05am daily. The chart below provides departure times for cities most likely to be of interest. If you arrive at Bradley International Airport (Hartford), and want to take the bus to Brattleboro, it is necessary to use a local bus to travel from the airport to the Greyhound bus station (Union Station) in Hartford. (A taxi is a more expensive alternative for the 13 mile trip.) Please see the URL site below for local bus departure times from the airport.

If you arrive at Logan International Airport (Boston), your most direct option for transportation to Brattleboro is to use Thomas Transportation. See [www.thomastransportation.com](http://www.thomastransportation.com). There is no direct bus service from Boston to Brattleboro. If you choose to use bus transportation from Logan, you would first travel westbound from the airport to Springfield, Massachusetts and, changing buses, continue north from Springfield to Brattleboro.
